ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 18185 for the following:

- splitting line 3 into lines 3, 24 and 25
- length amendment of line 5 from 0.18 kilometres to the revised length of 0.05 kilometres
- mapping amendment of line 5

The Commission amended Licence 18185 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 25812-D01-2020¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, subject to the following condition:

1. Within 90 days of issuance of the AUC approval, ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. shall file with the AUC confirmation that it has filed a OneStop update for Licence 18185 with the Alberta Energy Regulator.
