ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 102 for the following:

- "to location" amendment of line 52
- "from location" and "to location" amendment of line 61
- "from location" amendment of line 62

The Commission finds the proposed amendment to be necessary and hereby amends Licence 102 under Section 12 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, subject to the following condition:

1. Within 90 days of issuance of the AUC approval, ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. shall file with the AUC confirmation that it has filed a OneStop update for Licence 102 with the Alberta Energy Regulator.
