ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 7776 for the following:

- splitting line 6 into lines 6, 17, 18, 19, and 20
- removal of lines 17 and 19
- “from location” amendment of line 6

The Commission amended Licence 7776 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 25965-D01-2020¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, subject to the following condition:

1. Within 90 days of issuance of the AUC approval, ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. shall file with the AUC confirmation that it has filed a OneStop update for Licence 7776 with the Alberta Energy Regulator.
