

## Connection Order 25690-D03-2020 (Corrigenda)

On October 14, 2020, the Alberta Utilities Commission issued Decision 25690-D01-2020,<sup>1</sup> with Appendix 2 – Connection Order 25690-D03-2020 to Barlow Solar Park Ltd.

Appendix 2 to Decision 25690-D01-2020, permits connection of the Barlow Solar Park to ENMAX Power Corporation's 25-kilovolt distribution system. While ENMAX had confirmed its willingness to connect the Barlow Solar Park to ENMAX's electric distribution system, no connection voltage was stipulated. Section 48.3 of Rule 001: *Rules of Practice*, states that “[t]he Commission may issue a Corrigenda decision to correct an error in a decision or order that is not in the nature of a typographical, spelling, calculation error or other similar type of error.”

Appendix 2 to Decision 25690-D01-2020 has been amended to remove the specific reference to ENMAX's 25-kilovolt electric distribution system and allow Barlow Solar Park to connect to ENMAX Power Corporation's distribution system provided that it can demonstrate compliance with applicable rules, standards and ENMAX's interconnection requirements. The updated Connection Order 25690-D03-2020 is attached to this corrigenda document.

Barlow Solar Park Ltd., by Application 25690-A001, registered on June 25, 2020, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an order to connect the 27-megawatt Barlow Solar Park to ENMAX Power Corporation's distribution system.

The Commission approved the application in Decision 25690-D01-2020,<sup>1</sup> and granted Barlow Solar Park Ltd. an order to connect the Barlow Solar Park to ENMAX Power Corporation's distribution system, pursuant to Section 18 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*. This approval is subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. Barlow Solar Park Ltd. may connect the Barlow Solar Park to ENMAX Power Corporation's distribution system in Section 16, Township 23, Range 29, west of the Fourth Meridian, as indicated in the application.
2. The specifications of the connection shall be as set out in the application.
3. The connection shall be operated so that except under short-term emergency conditions:
  - (a) The flows of real and reactive power are those for which the connection is designed and which it is intended to carry on a continuous basis.
  - (b) No excessive surges of 60-hertz power or excessive exchange of power frequency harmonics shall occur between the systems connected.
4. This order is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.
