Sutton Energy Ltd. Time Extension to Construct the 3.5-Megawatt Natural Gas Wildwood Power Plant	Proceeding 26125 Application 26125-A001

Sutton Energy Ltd., pursuant to Approval 25485-D02-2020,¹ has approval to construct and operate a 3.5-megawatt (MW) power plant designated as the Wildwood Power Plant, located in Yellowhead County. The construction completion date for the power plant was stipulated to be on or before November 30, 2020.

Sutton, by Application 26125-A001, registered on November 26, 2020, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval to extend the completion date of the power plant.

The Commission, pursuant to sections 11 and 19 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, approved the application in Decision 26125-D01-2020,² and granted to Sutton an approval to construct and operate the power plant, subject to the provisions of *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The power plant shall be located in the southeast quarter of Section 28, Township 53, Range 9, west of the Fifth Meridian, as further described in Application 24801-A001.
2. The power plant shall consist of three reciprocating engine generators, with a total generating capability of 3.5 MW, and as further described in Application 24801-A001.
3. This approval is subject to the following conditions which have been described in Decision 24801-D01-2019:³
 - a. Sutton must advise the Commission, in writing, of Alberta Environment and Parks' decision on its *Environmental Protection and Enhancement Act* application prior to the start of construction.

- b. Once the final selection of equipment for the project is made, Sutton shall file with the Commission a noise study demonstrating that the project remains in compliance with the nighttime permissible sound level at Receptor R4. The study is to be filed no later than 90 days before construction is scheduled to begin.
4. Sutton shall notify the Commission within 30 days of completing construction of the power plant.
5. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, construction of the power plant shall be completed by August 3, 2021.
6. Sutton shall obtain Commission approval prior to making any substantive changes to the power plant or substantially varying the design or specifications of the power plant from what was stated in the application or what the Commission has approved.
7. This approval is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

Approval 25485-D02-2020 is rescinded.

The Commission may cancel or suspend this approval, in whole or in part, in accordance with Section 41 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* or may review this approval, in whole or in part, upon its own motion or upon an application by an interested party, in accordance with Section 10 of the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.

The Commission may, within 30 days of the date of this approval and without notice, correct typographical, spelling and calculation errors and other similar types of errors and post the corrected approval on its website.
