ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 2183 for the following:

- splitting line 1 into lines 1 and 2
- mapping correction of original line 1
- length amendment of original line 1 from 0.22 kilometres to the revised length of 0.26 kilometres.

The Commission amended Licence 2183 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 26087-D01-2020¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, subject to the following condition:

1. Within 90 days of issuance of the AUC approval, ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. shall file with the AUC confirmation that it has filed a OneStop update for Licence 2183 with the Alberta Energy Regulator.
