

Gas Utility Pipeline Record Amendment Licence 4799

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. Record Amendment	Proceeding 26153 Application 26153-A001

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 4799 to delete line 1 from the licence due to a transfer to low-pressure distribution service.

The Commission finds the proposed amendment to be necessary and hereby amends Licence 4799 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, subject to the following condition:

1. Within 90 days of issuance of the AUC approval, ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. shall file with the AUC confirmation that it has filed a OneStop update for Licence 4799 with the Alberta Energy Regulator.
