## Notice ENMAX Downtown District Energy Centre disposition application

Proceeding 26163 ENMAX Corporation

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering an application by ENMAX Corporation, as a designated owner of a public utility, for a declaration that its proposed disposition of the ENMAX Downtown District Energy Centre is exempt from the application of Section 101(2)(d)(i) of the *Public Utilities Act* or, in the alternative, an order approving the sale or disposition by ENMAX Corporation. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

## Written submissions are due January 4, 2021.
