ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. has filed applications for a pipeline licence transfer related to a gas utility pipeline acquisition in the Wabamun area

Proceeding 26189 Applications 26189-A001 and 26189-A002

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the gas pipeline licence transfer applications in Proceeding 26189. If you feel you may be affected by these applications you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

Written submissions are due January 21, 2021.

ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. has applied for an exemption pursuant to Subsection 26(4) of the *Gas Utilities Act*. In its application, ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. is seeking that the requirements of Subsection 26(2)(d) of the act not apply to the proposed sale and transfer to NOVA Gas Transmission Ltd. (NGTL) of the 29.9-kilometre (km) westerly segment of the Pioneer Pipeline Inc. pipeline and associated facilities that are within the NGTL geographic service area. Alternatively, if the Commission is not prepared to grant the exemption, ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. requests approval to sell and transfer the 29.9-km westerly segment of the Pioneer Pipeline Inc. pipeline and associated facilities to NGTL pursuant to Subsection 26(2)(d) of the act.

The Commission's approval of the applications in this proceeding would be contingent upon the Commission approving the applications filed in Proceeding 25937, wherein ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. requested approval to acquire ownership of and licences for approximately 130.3 kilometres of existing 508-millimetre outside-diameter high-pressure sweet natural gas pipeline from Pioneer Pipeline Inc. Because this proceeding deals with matters related to Proceeding 25937, this notice is also being distributed to participants with standing registered in Proceeding 25937.

The Commission is seeking written submissions by January 21, 2021, from parties with standing in Proceeding 25937, stating whether they object to or support the Commission granting the exemption or, alternatively, the approval applied for by ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. in this proceeding.

This notice will also be posted in Proceeding 25937.
