ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 16723 to amend the wall thickness of line 221.

The Commission finds the proposed amendment to be necessary for consistency with the Alberta Energy Regulator database and hereby amends Licence 16723 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*.
