## 2021 customer specific distribution access service rate (CS24) update application

### **Proceeding 26231 EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc.**

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc.'s 2021 customer specific (CS) distribution access service (DAS) rate update to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

EPCOR Distribution & Transmission Inc. has filed an application requesting approval for an updated 2021 DAS rate for an existing customer in the CS rate class, designated as customer "CS24." The customer has requested a change in configuration of the electrical service to accommodate upgrades of their electrical system, and therefore, EPCOR requests approval of the proposed updated 2021 DAS CS24 rate of \$576.39 per day with an effective date of May 1, 2021.

### **Written submissions are due January 27, 2021.**

To register your concerns, or your support for the application, please visit the AUC website and log in to the eFiling System to file your submission for Proceeding 26231. If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.
