2021-2023 tariff refund

Proceeding 26248 AltaLink Management Ltd.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the application for AltaLink Management Ltd.'s 2021-2023 tariff refund to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

AltaLink has filed an application requesting approval for its proposed 2021-2023 tariff refund. In its application, AltaLink proposes to refund \$150 million of previously collected future income taxes, and \$200 million of accumulated depreciation surplus, which would result in a reduction to its transmission tariff of \$131.2 million in 2021, \$123.6 million in 2022 and \$62.5 million in 2023.

Written submissions are due January 27, 2021.
