ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 18237 for the following:

- splitting line 11 into lines 11, 21 and 22
- removal of line 21
- length amendment of original line 11 from 7.32 kilometres to the revised length of 7.40 kilometres
- addition of newly constructed pipeline, line 23 – 0.03 kilometres of 323.9-millimetre outside diameter pipeline
- addition of newly constructed pipeline, line 24 – 0.02 kilometres of 323.9-millimetre outside diameter pipeline

The Commission amended Licence 18237 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act* and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 26190-D01-2020¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, subject to the following condition:

1. Within 90 days of issuance of the AUC approval, ATCO Gas and Pipelines Ltd. shall file with the AUC confirmation that it has filed a OneStop update for Licence 18237 with the Alberta Energy Regulator.
