Written submissions are due March 8, 2021.

If you do not have access to the internet, send your name, address, phone number, organization you are representing, description of your interest in the proceeding, position including information in support of the position and reasons why the AUC should decide in the manner recommended, and whether further process is required. If no written submissions are received, the Commission may make its decision without further notice or process.

Parties are advised that in advance of filing the application, EPCOR submitted a motion for confidentiality¹ related to certain material included in the application. The Commission issued its ruling on the motion on February 19, 2021, in which it granted the request for confidentiality in full. Parties who wish to have access to the confidential material are advised to refer to the confidentiality ruling² as well as to Section 28.11 of the Commission's Rule 001: Rules of Practice, for more information.
