In relation to the transfer of electric distribution system assets from BR REA to EPCOR, as directed in Decision 25300-D01-2020, based on the replacement cost (new) less depreciation method reflected in Section 29(4) of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, EPCOR proposed a compensation amount of \$758,001.
