

## Power Plant Approval 26123-D02-2021

1195714 Alberta Ltd. 45-Megawatt Empress NGL Cogeneration Power Plant	Proceeding 26123 Application 26123-A002

1195714 Alberta Ltd., by Application 26123-A002, registered on November 25, 2020, applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for approval to construct and operate a 45-megawatt (MW) natural gas-fuelled cogeneration power plant at the Empress NGL Straddle Plant in Cypress County.

Pursuant to Section 11 of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*, the Commission approved the application in Decision 26123-D01-2021,<sup>1</sup> and granted an approval to 1195714 Alberta Ltd. to construct and operate the power plant, subject to the provisions of the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations made under the acts, any orders made under the acts, the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, and the following terms and conditions:

1. The power plant shall be located in the northeast quarter of Section 2, Township 20, Range 1, west of the Fourth Meridian, as further described in the application.
2. The power plant shall consist of one natural gas-fuelled turbine generator, with a total generating capability of 45 MW, and as further described in the application.
3. Unless otherwise authorized by the Commission, construction of the power plant shall be completed by March 31, 2023.
4. 1195714 Alberta Ltd. shall notify the Commission within 30 days of completing the power plant.
5. 1195714 Alberta Ltd. shall obtain Commission approval prior to making any substantive changes to the power plant or substantially varying the design or specifications of the power plant from what was stated in the application or what the Commission has approved.
6. This approval is not transferable unless approved by the Commission.

The Commission may, within 30 days of the date of this approval and without notice, correct typographical, spelling and calculation errors and other similar types of errors and post the corrected approval on its website.
