Apex Utilities Inc. applied to the Alberta Utilities Commission for an amendment to Licence 1055 to replace an existing pipeline with a newly constructed 114.3-millimetre outside-diameter pipeline in the city of Leduc.

The Commission amended Licence 1055 under Section 11 of the *Pipeline Act*, and Section 4.1 of the *Gas Utilities Act* in Decision 26277-D01-2021¹ subject to the provisions of the *Pipeline Act*, *Gas Utilities Act* and the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, any regulations or orders made under the acts and the Commission rules made pursuant to the *Alberta Utilities Commission Act*, subject to the following condition:

1. Within 90 days of issuance of the AUC approval, Apex Utilities Inc. shall file with the AUC confirmation that it has filed a OneStop update for Licence 1055 with the Alberta Energy Regulator.
