

## Notice 2023-2025 general tariff application

Proceeding 27062 ATCO Electric Ltd.

The Alberta Utilities Commission, the independent utilities regulator, will be considering ATCO Electric Ltd.'s 2023-2025 general tariff application to ensure that the delivery of Alberta's utility service takes place in a manner that is fair, responsible and in the public interest. If you feel you may be affected by this application, you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

On May 19, 2022, ATCO Electric filed a 2023-2025 general tariff application with the Commission and requested:

- Approval of revenue requirements for the years 2023, 2024 and 2025 in the amounts of \$674.8 million, \$684.9 million and \$695.6 million, respectively.
- Continuation of all previously approved deferral and reserve accounts excluding the vegetation management deferral account, which ATCO Electric requests be discontinued.
- Approval of deferral treatment of ATCO Electric's 2025 information technology transition and managed services costs, and for a fuel price deferral account for the 2023-2025 test period.
- Approval to discontinue the collection of future income taxes expense.

The Commission requires each party registering to participate in this proceeding to include in their statement of intent to participate (SIP), or as an attachment to their SIP, the following information:

- Comments on ATCO Electric's proposed issues list.<sup>1</sup>
- Comments on ATCO Electric's proposed process schedule.<sup>2</sup>
- A full description of the issues proposed to be added to the issues list and why those issues are relevant and/or material to the testing of the application.

## Written submissions are due June 15, 2022.
