

Notice of amended application Winnifred Wind Power Plant Connection Project

Enerfin Energy Company of Canada Inc. and AltaLink Management Ltd. have filed applications for transmission development in the Medicine Hat area

Proceeding 26707 Applications 26707-A002 to 26707-A004

The Alberta Utilities Commission (AUC), the independent utilities regulator, will be considering the electric transmission development applications in Proceeding 26707. If you feel you may be affected by these applications you can provide input to the AUC to review before it makes its decision.

Written submissions are due July 7, 2022. Interveners who have already registered are asked to confirm whether they intend to continue to participate by this date as well.

Enerfin Energy Company of Canada Inc. has applied to construct and operate a new approximately 25-kilometre, 138-kilovolt (kV) transmission line, to be designated as Transmission Line 498L, to connect Enerfin's Winnifred Wind Power Project to the Alberta Interconnected Electric System, via Enerfin's Holsom 1054S Substation.

On May 27, 2022, Enerfin amended its application to propose a new route along Highway 523, Township Road 120 and Highway 3. The map included with this notice identifies Enerfin's newly proposed transmission line route. Enerfin had previously proposed a transmission line route along Township Road 114 and Highway 3 but has eliminated this route from consideration as part of its amendment.

AltaLink Management Ltd. has applied to connect the existing Bullshead 523S Substation to proposed Transmission Line 498L and to upgrade the Bullshead 523S Substation to accommodate this proposed connection.

The applications have been filed under the *Hydro and Electric Energy Act*.
